Applications are invited upto **23<sup>rd</sup> November 2017 (Thursday)** for one post of Scientist-B (Medical) (Epidemiology) under 'Un-Reserved' category in Level-10 of Pay Matrix under VII CPC (Pre-revised Pay Band PB-3 of Rs.15600-39100 with Grade Pay Rs.5400) plus NPA & other allowances as per Rules at the ICMR's National Institute of Epidemiology, Chennai.

**Essential qualification :**

M.B.B.S. Degree recognised by MCI.

**Desirable qualifications:**

- (i) M.D. in Preventive & Social Medicine / Community Medicine / General Medicine or Paediatrics / Master Degree in Epidemiology or Public Health from a recognised University.
- (ii) Two years Teaching / Research experience in Epidemiology / Public Health after obtaining essential qualification.
- (iii) Knowledge of Computer Applications.

**Age Limit :**

- (i) Not exceeding 35 years. Relaxable upto 5 years for Government servants and 10 years for Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates. This being a 'UR' vacancy, no age relaxation is admissible for SC/ST/OBC candidates.
- (ii) One time age relaxation is allowed to Scientific Staff working in long term projects of ICMR Institutes/Centres, as a one time measure with a view to provide them opportunity to compete with other candidates for posts advertised under Health Research Scientists Cadre of Indian Council of Medical Research Rules, 2007, for Direct Recruitment, as per Council's letter No.16/17/2010-Admn.II dated 10.3.2010.

**Job Requirement:**

The incumbent is required to plan and carry out clinical / Epidemiological studies in collaboration with medical colleges and health systems, do statistical analysis, prepare reports and suggest prevention and control strategies in communicable and non-communicable diseases. He / She will also be a faculty member in various training courses and programmes conducted by the Institute.

**General Relaxation clause:**

Age, Qualification and Experience will be relaxable in deserving cases as mentioned in the Recruitment Rules of Health Research Scientists cadre of ICMR, 2007 under Rule 14 and Note (i) & (ii) of Schedule III.

Other Service Conditions:

- (1) Level-10 of Pay Matrix under VII CPC [Pre-revised Pay Band (PB-3) Rs.15600-39100 + Grade Pay Rs.5400/-] plus NPA.
- (2) Allowances as per Central Government Rules are admissible on the above pay Scale.
- (3) Benefits of new restructured defined contributory Pension system are admissible as per the provision contained in the Ministry of Finance, Department of Economic Affairs (ECB & PR Division), Notification No.5/7/2003-ECB & PR dated 22.12.2003 effective from 1.1.2004.
- (4) Applications from employees working in Central/State Govt. Departments/Public Sector Undertakings and Govt. Funded research agencies must be forwarded through proper channel. Advance copies of application will be considered subject to the conditions that a "No Objection Certificate" from the employer is produced at the time of personal discussion. Application received after the closing date will not be considered. Candidates called for personal discussion have the option to answer in Hindi also.

How to apply:

- (2) Application forms duly completed in all respects and signed by the applicant should be sent to the Director-in-Charge, National Institute of Epidemiology, R-127, 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Tamil Nadu Housing Board, Ayapakkam, Chennai-600 077 on or before the closing date.
- (3) Documents to be enclosed with the application form (self attested copies):-
  - a) Proof of Date of Birth
  - b) Educational qualification
  - c) Experience
  - d) List of Publications with impact factor for each publication.
  - e) Crossed Indian Postal Order (IPO) / Demand Draft for Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) payable to the Director, National Institute of Epidemiology, Chennai. SC/ST/Women/Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates are exempted from the application fee. IPOs / DDs are payable by all other candidates including ICMR employees. Indian Scientists working abroad are exempted from application fee.
- (4) Unsigned/Incomplete application, application without required supportive evidence, applications without postal order / demand draft and applications received late shall be summarily rejected.

Note: 1) M.D. in relevant subject shall be treated equivalent to 3 years experience & MPH equivalent to 2 years experience. 2) Since it is not possible to call all the eligible candidates for the written test and personal discussion, the applicants will be short-listed for this purpose. The decision of the Director General, ICMR will be final in this regard. 4) Candidates called for written test / personal discussion will be paid a 2<sup>nd</sup> class rail fare by the shortest route on production of documents. Local transportation charges shall however be borne by the candidates themselves. 5) Any canvassing by or on behalf of the candidates or to bring political or other outside influence with regard to selection/recruitment shall be disqualification. 6) The post is with all India transfer liability under the Council.
