
Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) calculated as the weighted average of numerical values of grades with credits as weights.

Criteria for award of MPH degree

A minimum of grade B minus in all the courses and field projects with a minimum CGPA of 2 in total.

Internal Evaluation

End-course evaluations for each course/module

- Written exam/in-class or take-home assignment/seminar/ presentation - Course/module in-charge
- 2nd attempt in subsequent year

Evaluation of field projects

- Oral presentations 2 ICMR NIE faculty
- Field project report with at-least 1 manuscript
- Additional 10% marks for submission in scientific journals/ presentation in scientific conferences during the course period
- Eligibility for appearing in dissertation viva-voce

External Evaluation

Evaluation of dissertation at the end of academic year

- Dissertation manuscript graded by external examiner
- Oral presentation followed by viva-voce graded by external examiners
- 2nd attempt with subsequent cohort



ADMISSION TO THE PROGRAMME

Admission is open to government and private candidates. Preference to the candidates sponsored by the Central / State Governments / Union Territories and Armed Forces.

Eligibility Criteria

- M.B.B.S. degree recognized by National Medical Council
- (a) Working in public health, preferably regularized and permanent employees of State or Central Government Department or Medical institutions;

 (b) Private (Non-Government) candidates worked / working in public health
- Three years experience in public health related activities
- Age up to 45 years as on 1.7.2024. Departmental candidates from ICMR institutions granted age relaxation of 5 years. SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates eligible for age relaxation as per Government of India rules

Sponsorship

- The sponsoring authority (Central/State Government / Non-Governmental Organizations / Private Institutions) should nominate and depute the candidates for 2 years on a full time basis.
- Sponsored candidates should enclose Sponsorship letter from the employer, in original in the specified format (refer specimen given in the Application Form), along with the application or produce the same at the time of interview.
- If the candidates are not sponsored at the time of application, No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the employer or a letter mentioning that the candidate will be sponsored if selected for the course should be enclosed (refer specimen given in the Application Form).

Terms and Conditions of Selection

- Candidates selected for the course should be available for the entire duration of the course, i.e., 2 years on full time basis
- Candidates selected for the course should not do private practice or engage in any other employment, etc., during the Contact Sessions and Field Postings
- If a candidate is found to be engaged in a work other than course work, his/her admission to the course will be cancelled





Fees

- No course fee for deputed candidates from the State/Central Government Departments/Armed forces.
- One time Administrative Services fee Rs. 30,000/- to be paid at the time of admission to SCTIMST by both the deputed and non-deputed candidates.
- For the non-deputed government/private candidates and the deputed candidates from private institutions, the course fee is **Rs. 1,00,000**/- (Rupees One lakh only) (non-refundable), payable at the beginning of the course.

Method of selection

A Selection Committee constituted by SCTIMST and NIE will select the candidates based on the following:

Written test

Personal interview

Reservation of seats as per Government of India norms being followed by SCTIMST. Mere possession of the eligibility criteria will not entail selection for the course. The decision of the Director, SCTIMST, shall be final for selection of the candidates.

The prescribed application form given in the website or its photocopy alone should be used. Application in any other form will not be considered.

Application Fee

Applications should be submitted along with the application fee of **Rs.600/**-(Rupees Six hundred only) by means of a Demand Draft drawn on any nationalized bank in favour of "Director, NIE" payable at Chennai. Applications without the application fee will not be considered. Attach photocopy of Demand Draft with the application.
