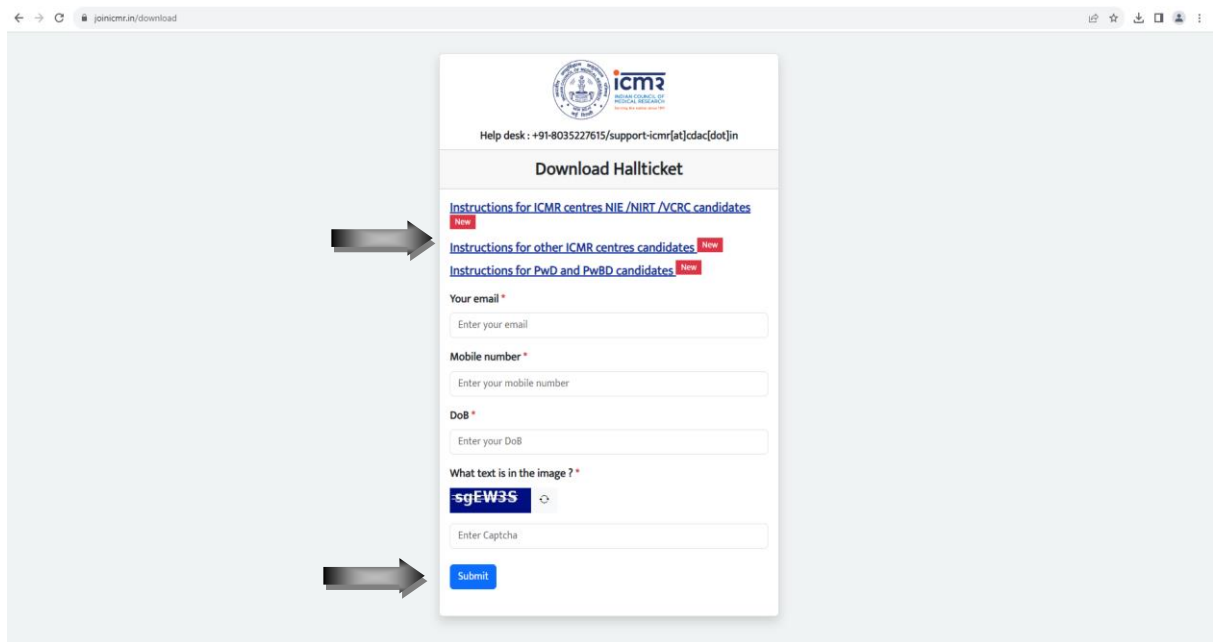
- (a) Candidates can download the Hall Tickets in the official website <https://joinicmr.in/login/user>. The following steps may be noted:

Step 1: Candidates are advised to click the option “Click to Download” in the home page of the Online Application portal.

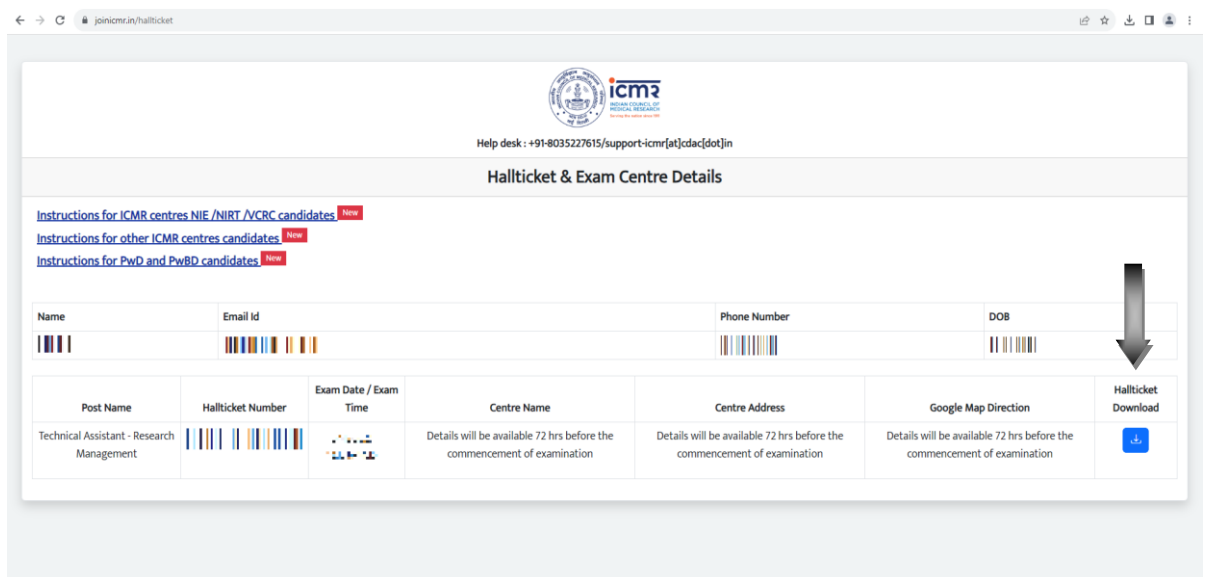

(e) The minimum essential qualifying marks (Cut off marks) for the CBT Examinations are as follows:

S No.	Categories	Technical Assistant	Laboratory Attendant - 1
01	For UR / EWS	60	50
02	For OBC	55	45
03	For SC / ST	50	40

(f) Additional weightage of marks for post essential qualification experience:

Candidates who possess Post Qualification research / lab / field experience in any Government recognized/ approved / registered Institution or Organization will be given additional marks as detailed in the following table:

The details of additional weightage marks are as follows:

Relevant Experience	Weightage (marks)
> 1 and upto 2 years	1
> 2 and < 4 years	2
> 4 and < 6 years	3
> 6 and < 8 years	4
>= 8 years	5

(Note: The Additional Weightage of marks will be awarded to the candidate fulfilling the eligibility criteria and after obtaining the minimum essential qualifying marks (cut off marks) as specified in the Point No. (e).

(g) Candidates working in the ICMR Projects continuously shall also be eligible for age relaxation up to **five years** provided he/she has entered into project service within prescribed age limit for the post.

Note: To avail this age relaxation, ICMR project staff should be currently working in any of the ICMR and its Institutes/Centres. Candidates who does not meet the above criteria, he/she will not be eligible to avail this relaxation.
